Thank you for your interest in becoming a member of the Board of Directors of Brant-Brantford Crime Stoppers. Crime Stoppers is a not-for-profit charitable organization. **As you may know, Crime Stoppers Programs receive no government funding and therefore rely on corporate, individual and court-ordered donations, as well as fundraising events to finance the Program.**

Board meetings are normally held at 5:45 p.m. on the third Tuesday of each month at the Brantford Police Service at 344 Elgin Street. During these meetings Board Members approve rewards for anonymous tipsters who have provided information that has helped solve a crime, as well as discuss other business and plan fundraising events. Since all funding to pay the rewards and run the program are received by donations or through fundraising, Board members are actively involved with special events, fairs and marketing projects.

Enclosed is an information package about Brant-Brantford Crime Stoppers, along with an application form and a police check form. The police check is mandatory for anyone associated with the Program and will be of no cost to you. **Please complete the documents and return them to the reception desk at the Brantford Police Service, in the envelope provided.** Once the application package is received and reviewed, a Director of the Board will contact you to arrange a time to meet with you to further discuss the Crime Stoppers Program.
